

# Information for Authors

---

The aim of the Iranian Journal of Electrical and Computer Engineering (IJECE) is to foster the growth of educational, scientific and industrial research activities among electrical and computer experts and engineers and to provide a medium for mutual communication between the Iranian academia and the industry on the one hand, and the world scientific community on the other.

The IJECE is a journal that publishes theoretical and experimental papers concerned with the research in different fields of electrical engineering and computer science. Intentionally a broad scope has been considered for the journal and the boundaries of acceptable subject matter are not sharply delimited. Rather, it is hoped to attract potential readers and contributors among larger scientific communities and to provide the ground for the presentation of the research results in multidisciplinary areas. Moreover, it is also hoped that as the focus of research activity changes, a flexible policy will permit this journal to follow suit.

The IJECE solicits paper submission from people who present new theoretical developments and techniques. Topics of interests within the scope of this journal include any original research contribution in any field of electrical or computer science and engineering. Contributions should comprise novel and previously unpublished material; however, prior publication in conference proceedings of an abstract, summary, or other abbreviated, preliminary form of the material shall not preclude publication in this journal when notice to such prior or concurrent publication is given at the time of submission. The novelty will usually lie in original results, methods, observations, concepts, or applications, but may also reside in synthesis of, or new insights into, previously reported research. Thus surveys and expository papers are also welcome.

Novelty alone does not assure publication; the significance of a paper and its usefulness to the journal readership also will be assessed. Notice of prior submission of the material must be given at the time of submission to this journal; thereafter, submission elsewhere is precluded unless the material is refused for publication or is withdrawn by the author before the reception of IJECE conditional/unconditional acceptance letter.

In submissions, the title, abstract, index terms, introduction, and summary should be sufficiently informative to make the gist of the paper clear to the broadest possible audience and to place the contributions of the paper in context with related work. The body of the paper should be understandable without undue effort by its intended audience. Supporting material not of central interest is best relegated to appendixes. Each submission should include an informative abstract of not more than 200 words. A list of index terms (key words and phrases) should be given after the abstract, a total of five to ten words in length. The terms should be relatively independent, and as a group, should characterize the paper.

Equations must be numbered consecutively in the same order of their appearance in the manuscript. The same rule

is applied to figures, references and tables.

Prospective authors should submit electronically their manuscript enclosed to an Email submission request message to the Editor-in-Chief of the IJECE via [ijece@iust.ac.ir](mailto:ijece@iust.ac.ir) or [editor@ijece.org](mailto:editor@ijece.org) Email addresses. Although there is no page format restriction for the submissions, the acceptable file formats are Microsoft WORD, PDF and Postscript.

Authors are encouraged to always submit a hard-copy of their manuscript by ordinary mail separately. The paper manuscript provides an essential backup should there be compatibility issue with the electronic manuscript. When submitting, please specify a contact person with postal address, phone number, fax number, and e-mail address. Authors who have do not have access to Internet for electronic submission may send four paper copies of their manuscript.

Please take note that submission of a manuscript amounts to assurance that it has received proper clearance from the author's company or institution, that it has not been copyrighted, published or accepted for publication in another journal, that is not currently being considered for publication in another journal, and will not be submitted elsewhere while under consideration by IJECE.

No page charge is applied for accepted paper up to eight pages, however the pages exceeded have to pay sub-charges (\$50/page). In consideration for the assignment of copyright, the publisher will supply electronic reprint of each accepted paper. Printed reprints can be ordered at extra cost at the proof-stage. Moreover, color printing of figures is available just for vital cases and part of costs must be compensated by authors.

Manuscripts submitted will be reviewed at least by three referees according to the editorial procedure and standards of the Iranian Journal of Electrical and Computer Engineering. All communications between authors, editors, and referees are performed by Email, thereby expediting the review process.

It is the policy of the publisher to own the copyright to the technical contributions it publishes on the interests of the IJECE, its authors, and their employers, and to facilitate the appropriate reuse of this material by others. To conform to the IJECE policy, authors are required to sign an IJECE copyright form at the time of manuscript submission. This form returns to authors and their employers full rights to reuse their material for their own purposes. Authors are required to submit a signed copy of the copyright form with their manuscripts.
